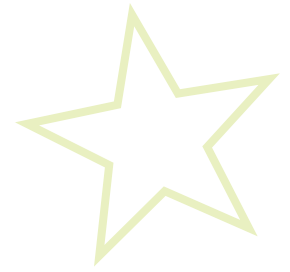




BRIDGETTE NICHOLS
