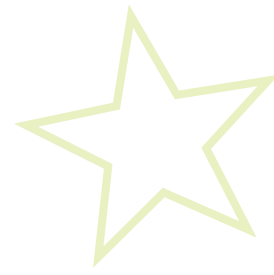




JEMMA CRONEY
